The Special Meeting of the Pope County Board of Commissioners duly noticed for January 28, 2020 was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Board Chair Gordy Wagner with the following members present: Commissioners Paul Gerde, Nan Haggerty, Larry Lindor, and Cody Rogahn. Kersten Kappmeyer, County Coordinator was present and Neil Nelson, County Attorney was not present.


The Board conducted interviews with the following finalist candidates for the position of Pope County Facilities Director: Ryan Robards, Kraig Thompson, and Bradley Pierce.

After completion of the interviews, the Board entertained discussion of the candidates and considered action to appoint. On motion by Haggerty, seconded by Rogahn, and unanimously carried, the Board authorized the County Coordinator to offer an appointment to the position of Facilities Director to Bradley Pierce. Discussion was briefly had regarding the position of Maintenance Technician currently held by Bradley Pierce. On motion by Rogahn, seconded by Gerde, and unanimously carried, the Board authorized the Coordinator's Office to post an opening for and fill the position of Maintenance Technician, contingent on Pierce's acceptance of the Facilities Director position.
