



POPE COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 202404

REPEALING OUTDATED PROVISIONS OF THE POPE COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Pope County Ordinance No. 201001, the Pope County Environmental Health Administrative Ordinance, adopted May 18, 2010, contained general provisions for rules and regulations governing public health licensure and fees no longer identified as necessary by public health officials due to adoption of more specific public health ordinances, specifically, Pope County Ordinance Nos. 201501, 201502, 201503, 201504, and 201505; and

WHEREAS, the Pope County Board of Commissioners hereby intend to repeal an ordinance such as Pope County Ordinance No. 201001, which contains outdated language regarding public health regulation, now superseded by more specific enactments;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Pope County Board of Commissioners does hereby ordain:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING OUTDATED PROVISIONS OF THE POPE COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE

Section 1. REPEALER

- 1.1 Ordinance No. 201001, the Pope County Environmental Health Administrative Ordinance shall be deemed repealed in its entirety from an after the effective date of this Ordinance, provided this repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred, or any right established prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.
- 1.2 Nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to reach or affect the provisions of any other Ordinance on the subject of Public Health or Environmental Health regulation, including but not limited to, Ordinance Nos. 201501, 201502, 201503, 201504, 201505, or any successor ordinance on this subject.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
